If you've got a threenager in your house, you know what a challenge it can be.....

They're learning to manage their emotions-3-year old's start to understand their emotions. They begin identifying their feelings with words. However, they're still not developmentally ready to control their emotions. Their emotions are intense & can seem overwhelming.

They want instant gratification-3-year old's don't have much impulse control. If they feel the need to do something, they'll act on it without much thought.

They're learning how to solve conflict- 3-olds may hit, bite or push as a way to deal with conflict. They act in the moment on impulse, they don't understand the difference between appropriate & inappropriate conflict resolution skills.

They're developing a sense of humour- 3-year-olds are learning how to be funny, like most children at this age, talking about things like *poo poo* and *pee* can be very entertaining.

They're learning empathy- They can relate to others when they're hurt, & you can get a response from them when you ask how they're feeling. They might also cry if they think they hurt you, especially if they didn't mean to.

They're learning to play with others- Before the age of three there's a lot of parallel play, but at this age, they start to engage with each other. They may even start asking you to play with them, too!

It's important for everyone caring for a child at this delicate age to remember that consistency & patience are key. Don't take their words personally, & try to explain things without getting overly emotional or angry. Good Luck!!!! Kathryn McHugh
